SCHEID FAMILY WINES



In 2000, we evolved into winemakers, making contract wine for numerous wineries, from large, well-known companies to small, boutique offerings. In 2011, after almost 40 years of growing grapes and making wine for others, we decided it was time to branch out into producing wines under our own labels. Today our annual sales are over 500,000 cases and our wines are distributed in all 50 states and numerous countries abroad.

We currently farm 12 estate vineyards covering 4,000 acres along a 70-mile stretch of the Salinas Valley. We are family-owned and operated and pride ourselves on being vertically integrated from grapes to glass, ensuring consistency of quality vintage after vintage. At Scheid Family Wines, we hold dear our longstanding traditions of family, sustainability, outstanding value and world-class wines.
