The Pinot Noir hails from this special 340-acre estate benchland vineyard. Aged for 12 months in (37% new) French oak, the final blend of grapes was a selection of the top barrels. An undoubtable sweet earthiness exudes from the glass, along with fragrances of cranberry, currants and rhubarb. Flavors of bright red cherry, saddle leather and incense are punctuated by high-stride acidity. White pepper leads to red pepper with a vibrant reappearance of cranberry. A vanilla cedar spice on the finish brings it all together.
