★ In June 2020, Sunny with a Chance of Flowers, a zero sugar, low calorie, low alcohol wine, was launched and marks SFW's entry into the burgeoning "Better for You" category. Sunny is the only wine that states zero sugar on its eye-catching label and aims to offer transparency in labeling to the consumer.
