
PASO POINT

VINEYARDS

The grapes for Paso Point are carefully sourced from select vineyards in Paso Robles—a region widely regarded as one of the best places to grow Cabernet Sauvignon. The label artwork recognizes Paso's proximity to the Pacific Ocean, which is only six miles from the region's western border. Strong ocean winds make their way through the coastal mountain ranges via the Templeton Gap, delivering a dramatic cooling effect that allows the grapes to develop complex flavors.

TASTING NOTES

Bold and rich, Paso Point Cabernet Sauvignon opens with aromas of black cherry, plum, black currant and vanilla that translate effortlessly on the palate. Showcasing a perfectly balanced integration of structure, fruit and elegant tannins, this Cabernet keeps on giving with a soft, lingering black fruit finish. Pair with roast beef tenderloin, portobello mushroom burger, beef brisket or aged cheeses such as cheddar or gouda.
