VINEYARDS

The grapes for Paso Point are carefully sourced from select vineyards in Paso Robles—a region widely regarded as one of the best places to grow Sauvignon Blanc. The label artwork recognizes Paso's proximity to the Pacific Ocean, which is only six miles from the region's western border. Strong ocean winds make their way through the coastal mountain ranges via the Templeton Gap, delivering a dramatic cooling effect that allows the grapes to develop complex flavors.

TASTING NOTES

Crisp and clean, Paso Point Sauvignon Blanc opens with aromas of white peach, grapefruit, citrus zest and a gentle note of fresh herbs. On the palate, tropical notes of passionfruit, guava and pear are complemented by hints of fresh herbs and minerality. This wine's crisp acidity lends a beautiful freshness and structure, making it incredibly versatile. Enjoy on its own as an aperitif, or with a wide range of foods including oysters, prawns, fish, roasted chicken or spicy Thai cuisine.
