PASO ROBLES

The defining characteristics of the Paso Robles terroir are the wide diurnal temperature variance (as much as 50°F) and limited nutrients in the soil with an excellent balance of well-draining, calcareous shale and water-holding clay. With summer temperatures that frequently hit 100°F, it is this convergence of climate factors that ensure Mina Mesa is ripe, vibrant and balanced.

TASTING NOTES

Full bodied and bold, Mina Mesa Zinfandel unfolds with aromas of ripe plum, raspberry and red currant accentuated by subtle notes of vanilla and oak. Bright, bold flavors lead into a lingering red fruit finish.
