IN-VINEYARD NATIVE YEAST FERMENTATION

Metz Road specializes in small lot, single vineyard Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from our Riverview Vineyard in Monterey. These wines were born from the passion to express the unique *terroir* of this single site with minimal intervention.

REASONS TO BELIEVE

- In-Vineyard Fermentations: Some of our Chardonnay and Pinot Noir
 is fermented in new French oak barrels or small bins stored in a
 temperature-controlled, upcycled shipping container at our estate
 Riverview Vineyard to preserve the integrity of the wild yeast.
- Native Yeast Fermentations: A portion of the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay is fermented without inoculating—allowing the native yeast in the vineyard to lead the fermentation. This enhances aromatics and textures and preserves the signature of the terroir.
- 100% Riverview Vineyard: Located on a benchland on the eastern slopes of the Salinas Valley, Riverview is a cool-climate vineyard perfect for crafting Burgundian-style Chardonnay and Pinot Noir.
